Subj: MARINE CORPS JROTC TEXAS ROUND-UP DRILL MEET

1. The Jack C. Hays High School MCJROTC Drill Meet will be held at Jack C. Hays High School on 15 January 2022. Jack C. Hays High School is located at 4800 Jack C. Hays Tr, Buda, TX 78610. 2. The meet will consist of the events listed below. **Teams are not authorized to use lightweight rifles, flags or other similar equipment.**

- a. Inspection
- b. Regulation Drill (armed) (100X75ft)
- c. Regulation Drill (unarmed) (100X75ft)
- d. Exhibition Drill (armed) (100X75ft)
- e. Exhibition Drill (unarmed) (100X75ft)
- f. Color Guard Drill (Primary) (70X60ft)
- g. Academics - 10 Cadets, no uniform requirement.
- h. *Color Guard Drill (Secondary) (70X60ft)
- i. *Unarmed Knockout Drill (no charge)
- j. *Marine Corps Combat Fitness Test (CFT) (5 per team, at least 2 females on each team)
 - a. 880 yards Run
 - b. Ammunition can lift
 - c. Maneuver-under-fire

* Does not count towards the overall meet championship.

3. Schools may enter a maximum of one team in each event. The teams will compete for trophies in each event. CFT teams will consist of five members, two of which must be female. Individuals competing in drill may compete in more than one category (ex. Armed regulation and unarmed exhibition).

4. Three trophies will be awarded in each event. Individual awards will be presented in knockout drill. The overall meet

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trophies (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) will be awarded to the units with the highest number of combined points in inspection, regulation drill (armed and unarmed), exhibition drill (armed and unarmed), color guard, and Academics. Marine Corps Combat Fitness test and Color guard (secondary) will be awarded trophies (1st, 2nd, and 3rd).

5. A judges meeting will be held at 0730 in the Jack C. Hays MCJROTC building on meet day to discuss the rules and scoring.

7. The Competition will commence at 0800. A detailed schedule will be published when meet participants are finalized. Awards will be presented to cadets in formation as soon as all events are completed and scores are tallied. Civilian attire is not appropriate attire to receive awards, but school sanctioned travel suits may be worn.

8. Judging will be by active duty personnel and University of Texas Corps of Cadets personnel representing all services.

10. Classrooms will be available as dressing rooms and meeting areas.

11. A concession stand will be available, **No food or drinks will be allowed in the classroom.**

12. Restrooms are available in the school.

13. Cadets should remain in the school area unless supervised by their instructor. Your help will ensure the school grounds are maintained in a proper state of police for the beginning of school on Monday.

14. All changes will occur prior to the commencement of the meet and instructors will be notified.

15. Trophies will be awarded at the end of the meet. If you will not be available to receive trophies, it is your responsibility to make arrangements. We will not mail trophies.

16. Upon arrival at Jack C. Hays High School the team sponsor should report to the check in table, located at the front entrance of the school. Instructors should verify team/event times and receive their check-in package with updated

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instructions. An escort will then show each team to their assigned rooms.

17. Buses will be staged in a nearby parking area, see <https://www.haysmcjrotc.com/drill-meet.html>.

18. Security of uniforms, weapons, etc. in the classrooms provided, is the responsibility of each unit.

19. **Check-Out:** Once a school has completed their events they are asked to conduct a good police of their rooms. A "Check-Out" station will be located outside the cafeteria in the main building. Schools should have their senior cadet report to "Check-Out" and accompany a Hays cadet officer to inspect the rooms and "clear" the school.

20. Entry fee per school is a flat rate of \$400.
